The Republic of Belarus is ranked thirteenth among the European countries for its land area and fifth among the CIS countries for its population size after Russia, Ukraine, Uzbekistan and Kazakhstan.



MAIN CHARACTERISTICS OF THE REPUBLIC OF BELARUS

STATE STRUCTURE OF THE REPUBLIC OF BELARUS

The Republic of Belarus is a unitary, democratic, socially oriented and legal state.

Supreme power in the Republic of Belarus is vested in the President of the Republic of Belarus, the Parliament and the Government of the Republic of Belarus, and judicial bodies of the Republic of Belarus.

The President of the Republic of Belarus is the Head of State.

The Parliament - the National Assembly of the Republic of Belarus - is the representative and legislative authority of the Republic of Belarus consisting of two chambers - the House of Representatives and the Council of the Republic.

Executive power in the Republic of Belarus is vested in the Government - the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Belarus.

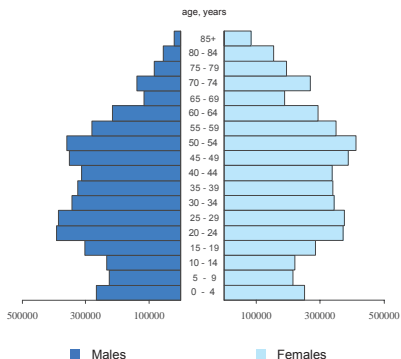

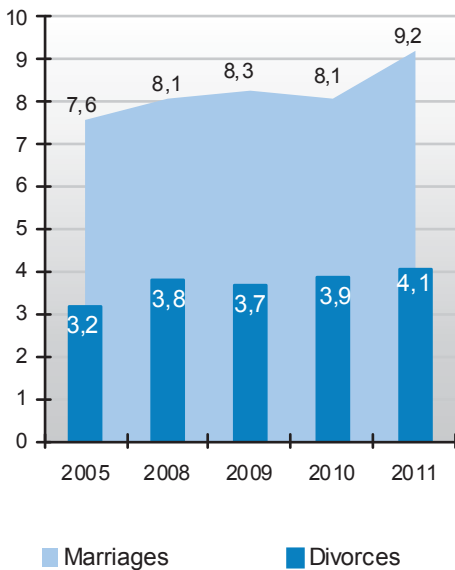

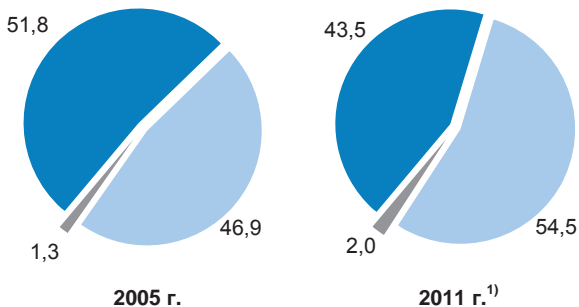

(percent of total number of employed)



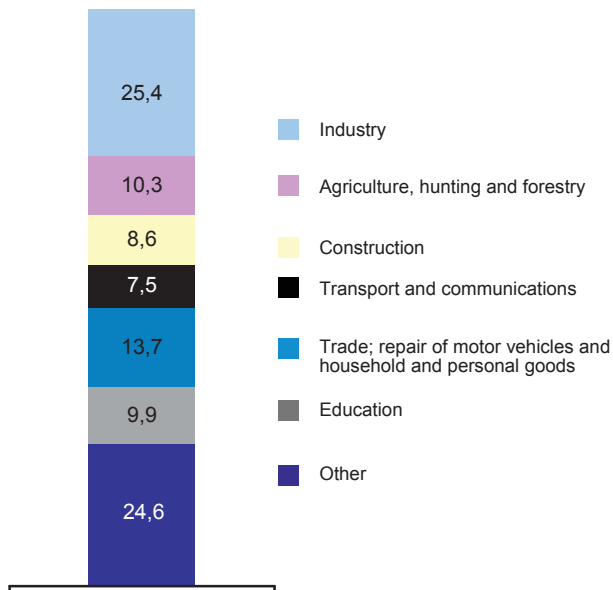

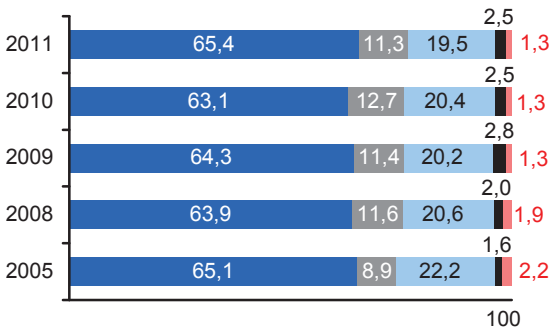

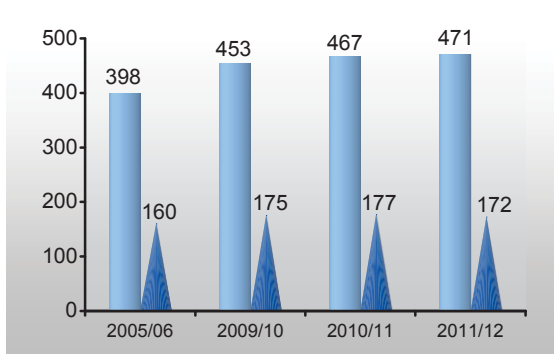

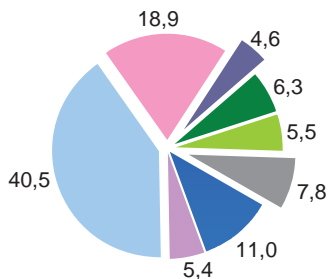

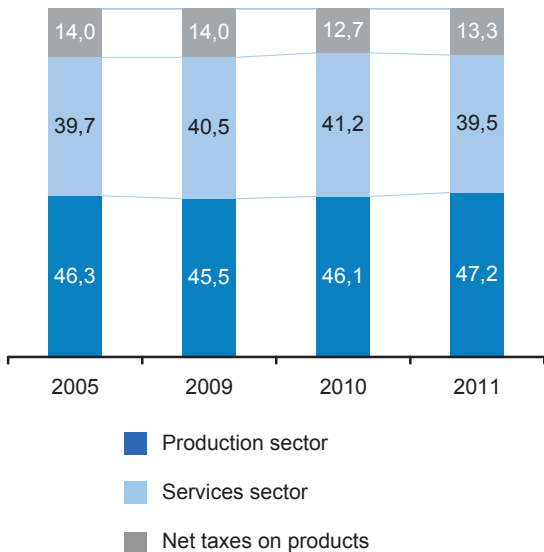

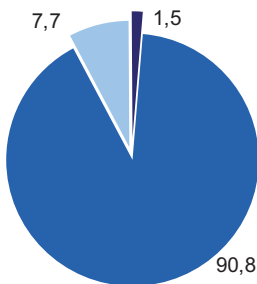

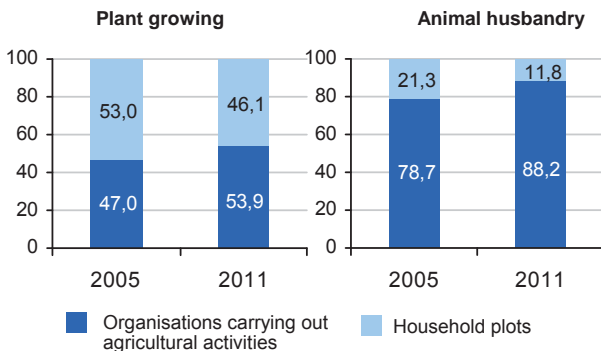

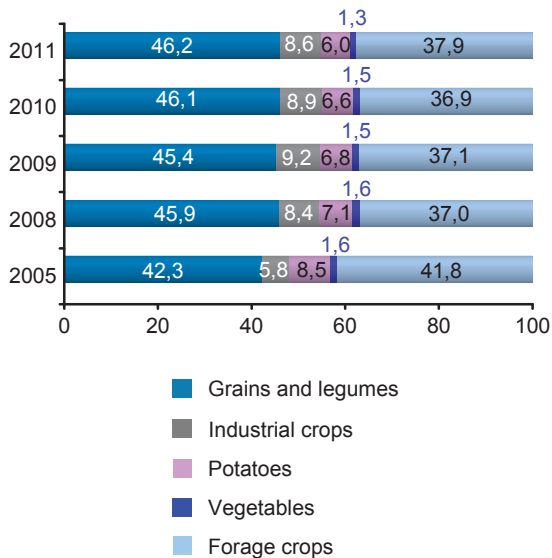

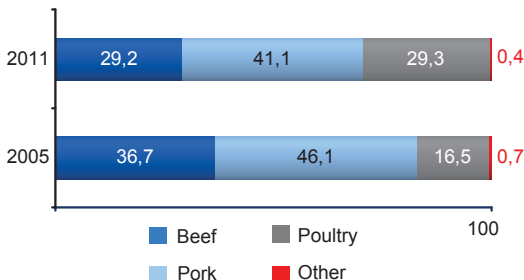

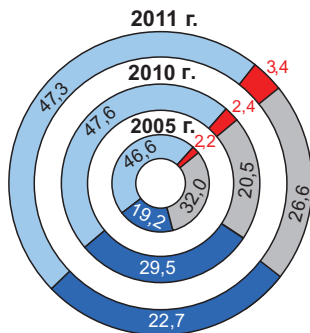

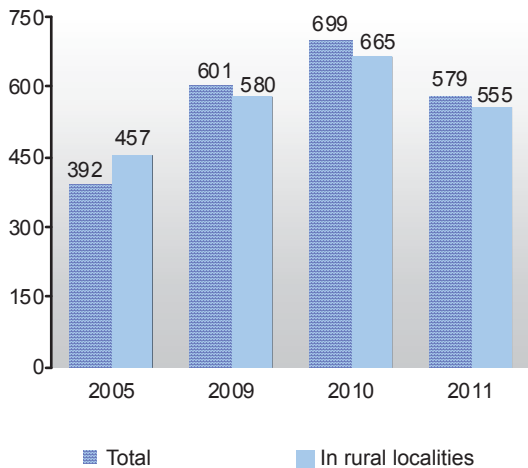

(square metres of total floor space)

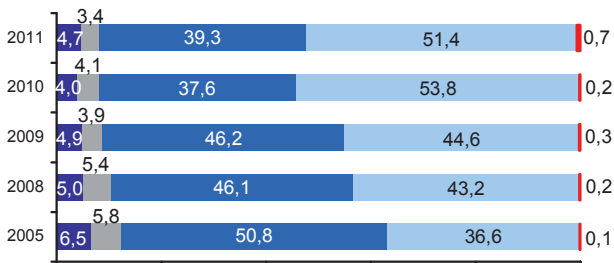

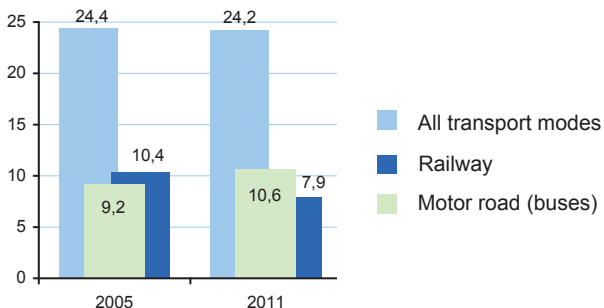

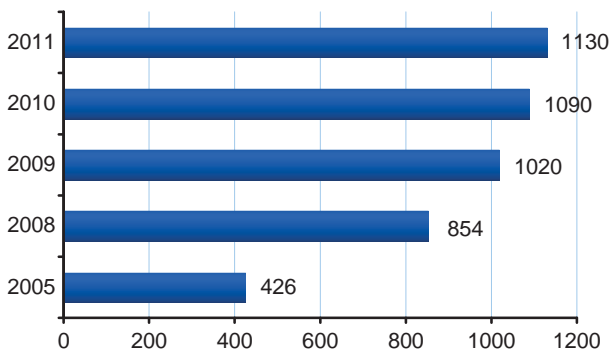

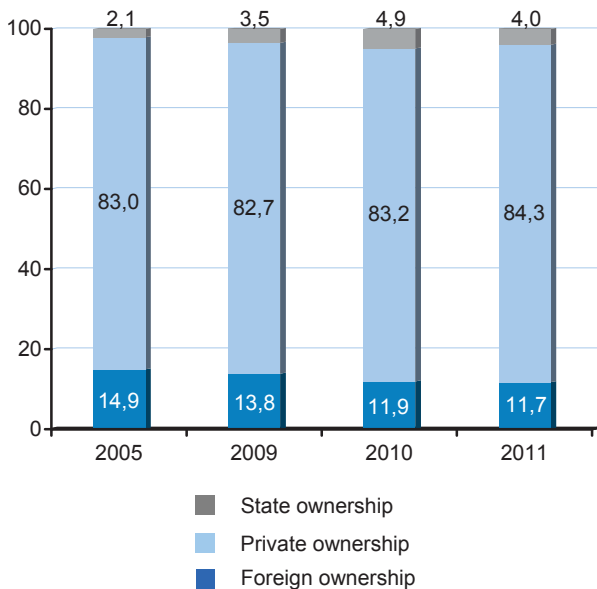

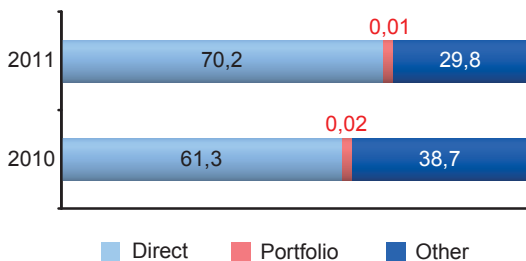

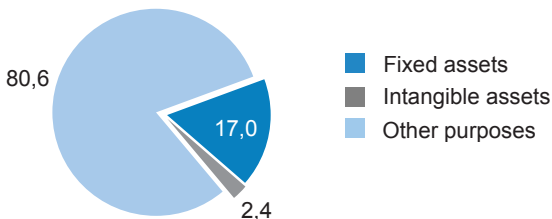

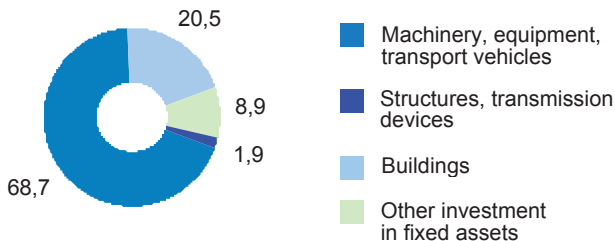
TARGETED CHANNELLING OF FOREIGN INVESTMENT

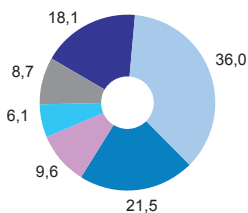

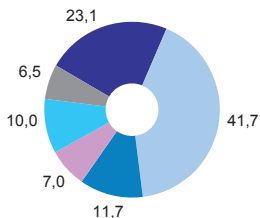
COMMODITY STRUCTURE OF EXPORTS AND IMPORTS IN 2011
