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The statistical reference book is an annual publication that provides brief information on the socio-economic situation in the Republic of Belarus.

Selected data for 2017 were revised as compared to those published earlier; in some cases data for 2018 are preliminary and may be revised in further issues.

From 2016 data by economic activity are presented in accordance with the national classification of the Republic of Belarus OKRB 005-2011 «Kinds of economic activity» (OKED). To ensure comparability, data by economic activity for 2015 were recalculated according to the new version of the classification.

Data in value terms are shown at current prices; data from 2016 are provided in terms of the new denomination effective from July 1, 2016 (1 BYN = 10 000 BYR).

MAIN CHARACTERISTICS OF THE REPUBLIC OF BELARUS

STATE STRUCTURE

The Republic of Belarus is a unitary democratic social state governed by the rule of law.

The state power in the Republic of Belarus is exercised on the principle of its separation into legislative, executive and judicial branches.

The President of the Republic of Belarus is the Head of State, the guarantor of the Constitution of the Republic of Belarus, of the rights and freedoms of a human and a citizen.

The Parliament – the National Assembly of the Republic of Belarus – is a representative and legislative body of the Republic of Belarus, consists of two Houses: the House of Representatives and the Council of the Republic.

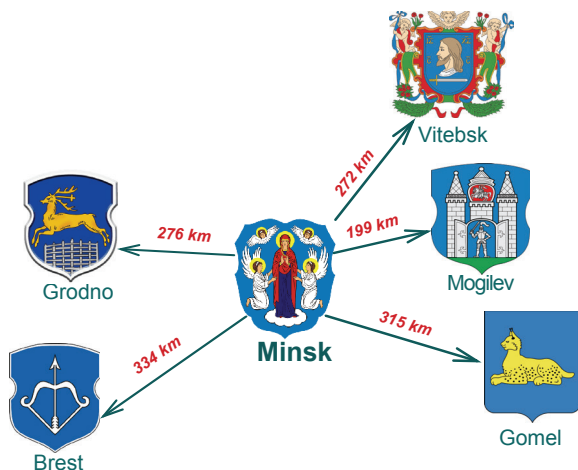
The executive power in the Republic of Belarus is exercised by the Government - the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Belarus.

The judicial power in the Republic of Belarus is vested in courts.

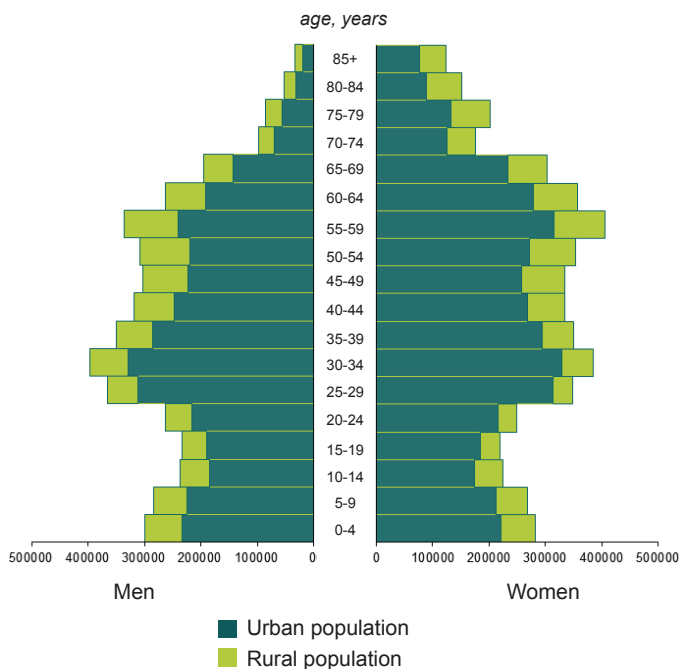

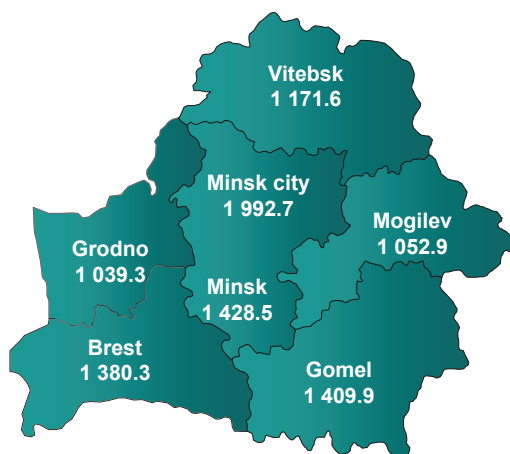

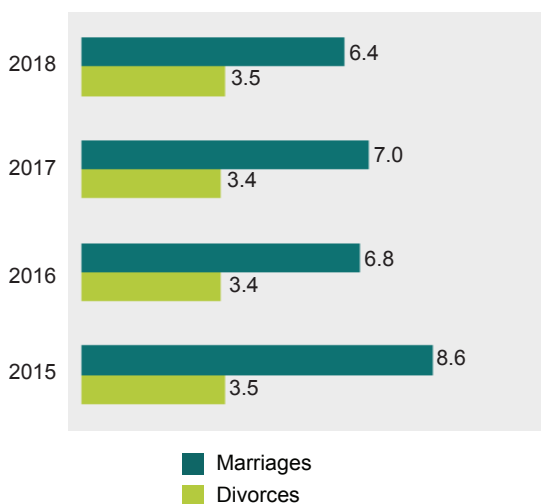

AVERAGE AGE AT MARRIAGE (years)

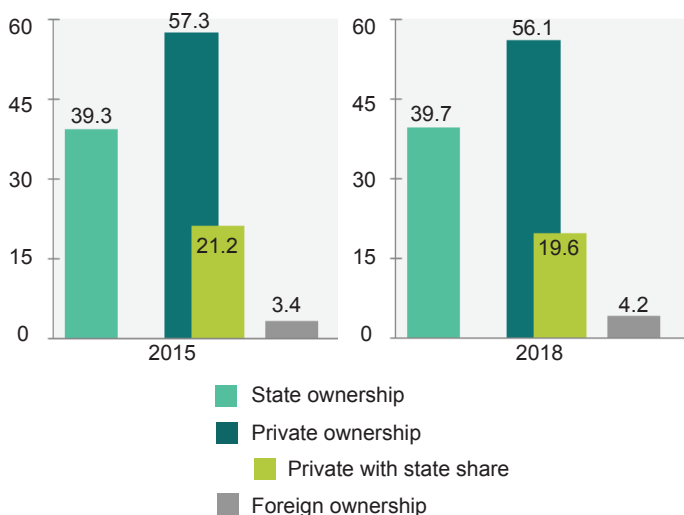

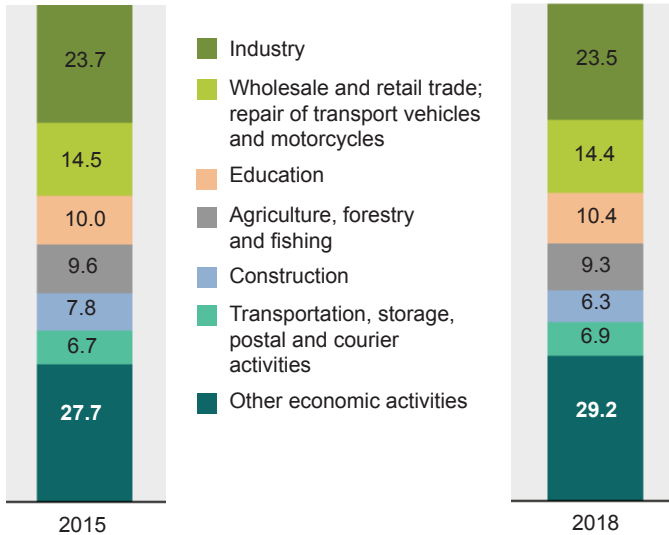

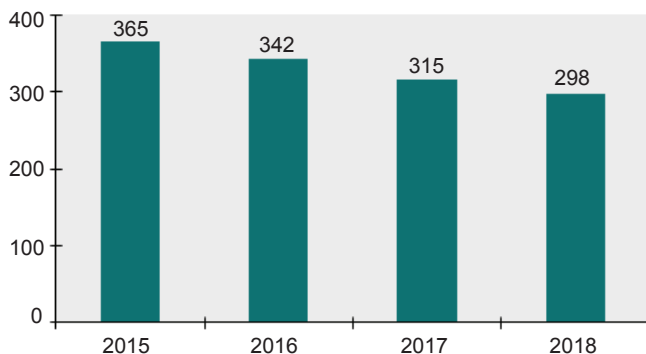

(beginning of academic year; persons)



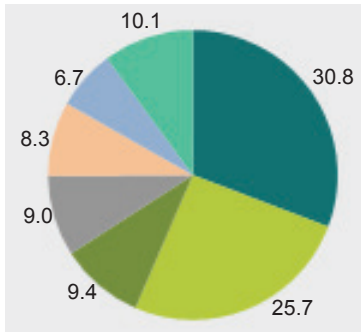

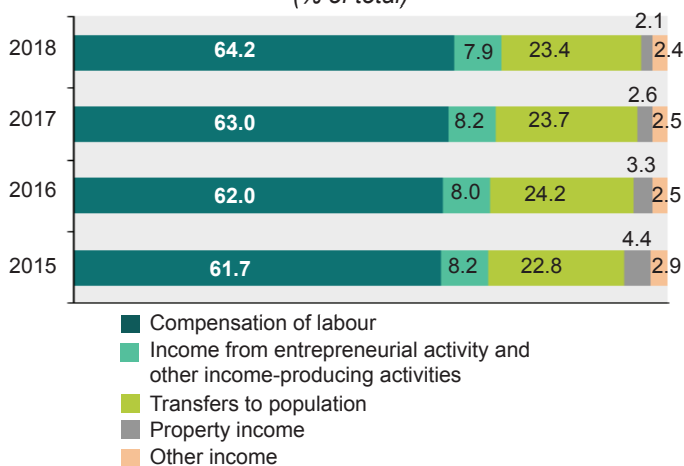

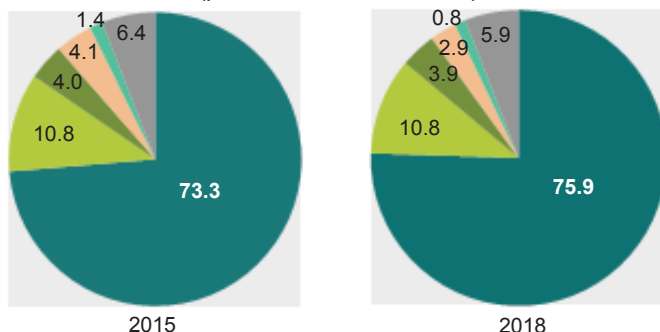

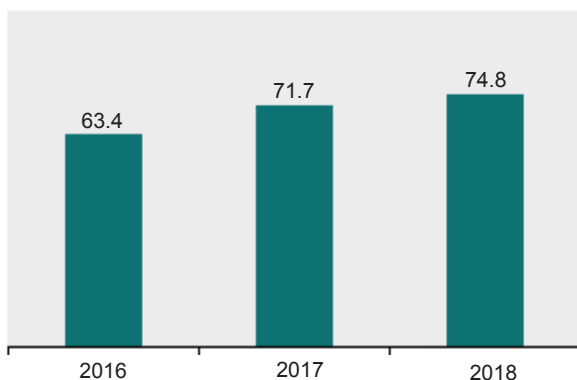

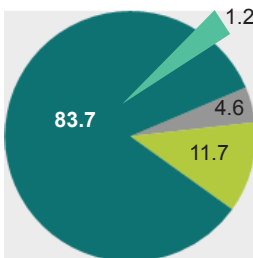

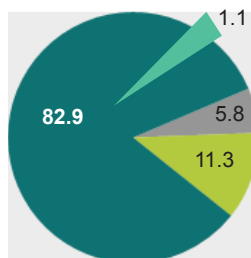

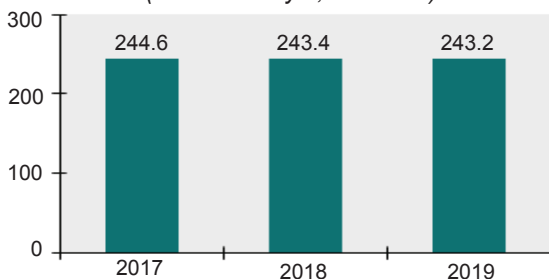

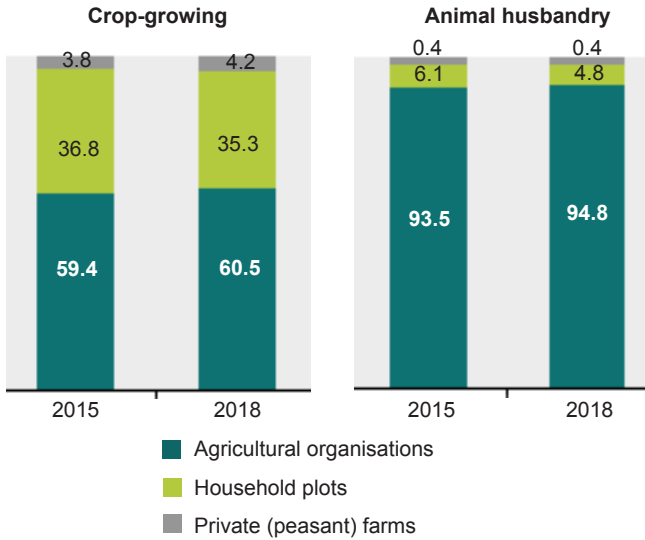

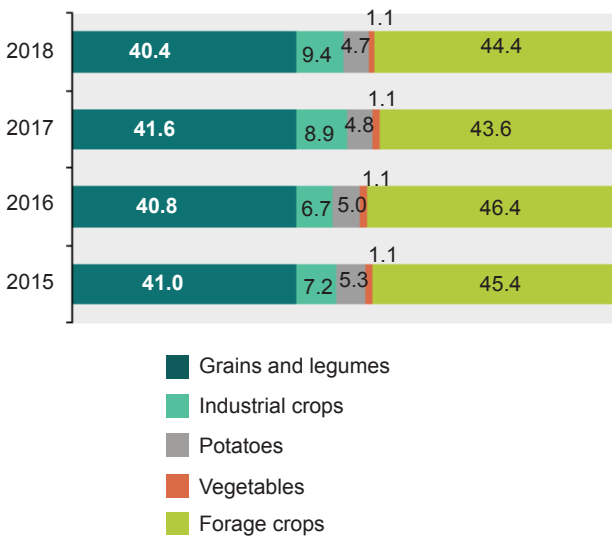
STRUCTURE OF CROP-GROWING AND ANIMAL HUSBANDRY PRODUCTION BY TYPE OF FARM

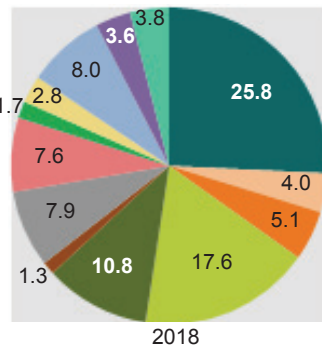

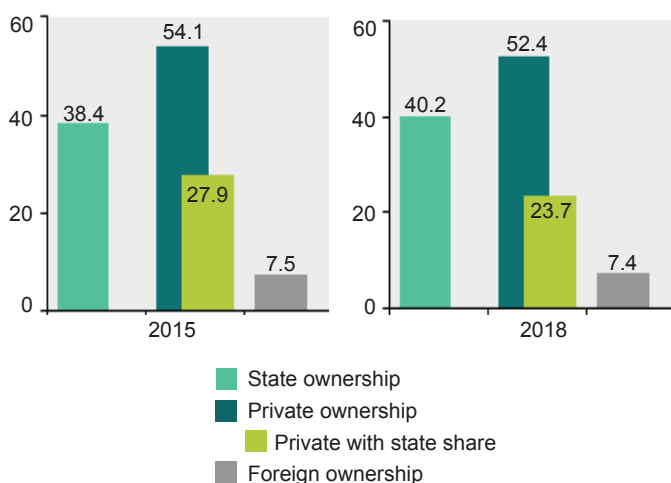

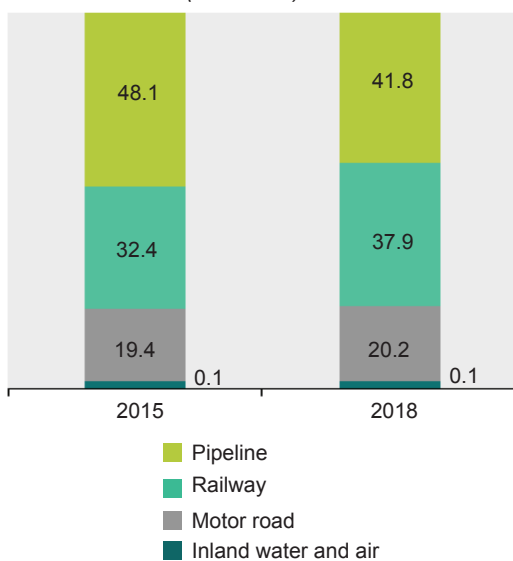

STRUCTURE OF FREIGHT TURNOVER BY MODE OF TRANSPORT (% of total)

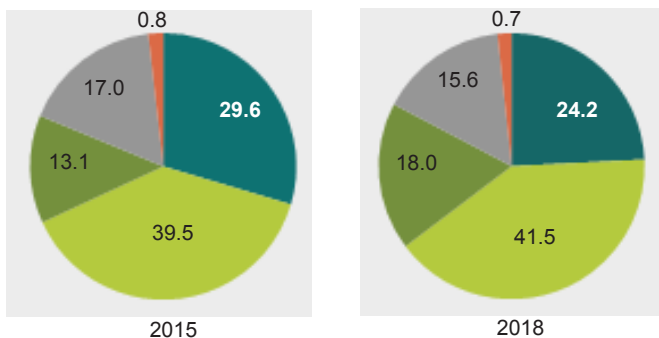

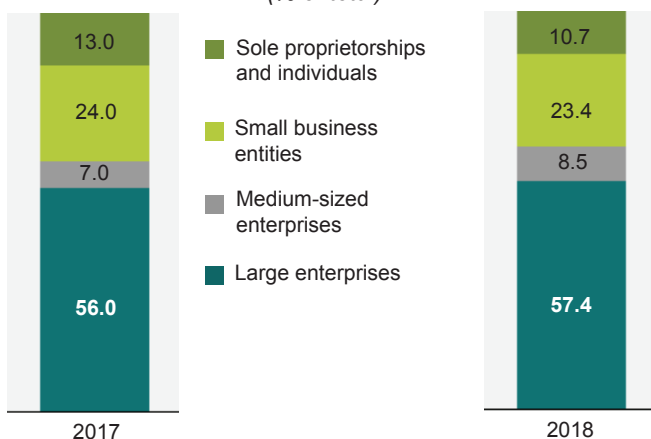

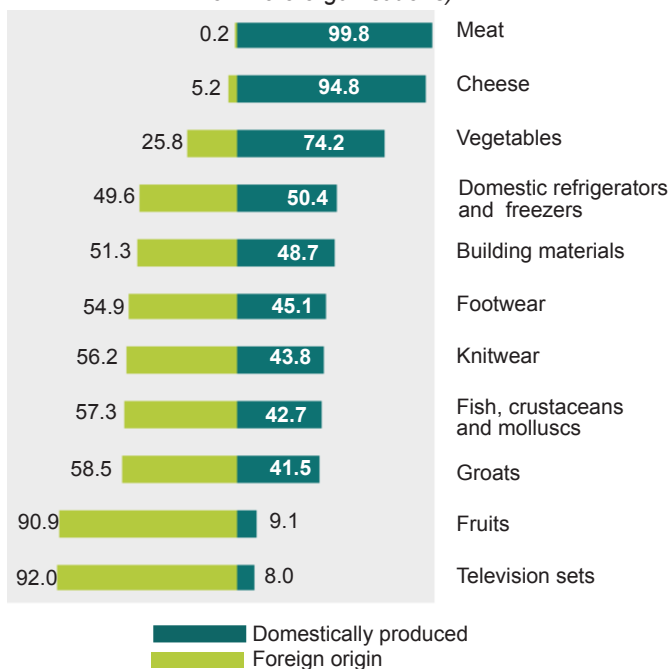
STRUCTURE OF RETAIL TURNOVER BY ECONOMIC ENTITIES

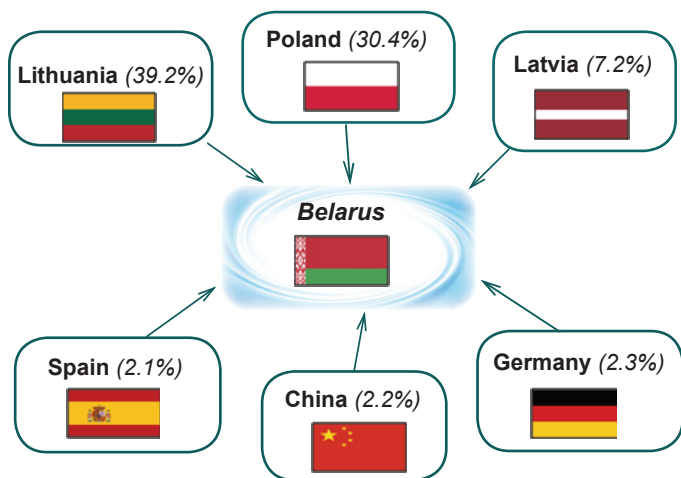

COUNTRIES WITH THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF TOURISTS IN 2018¹⁾

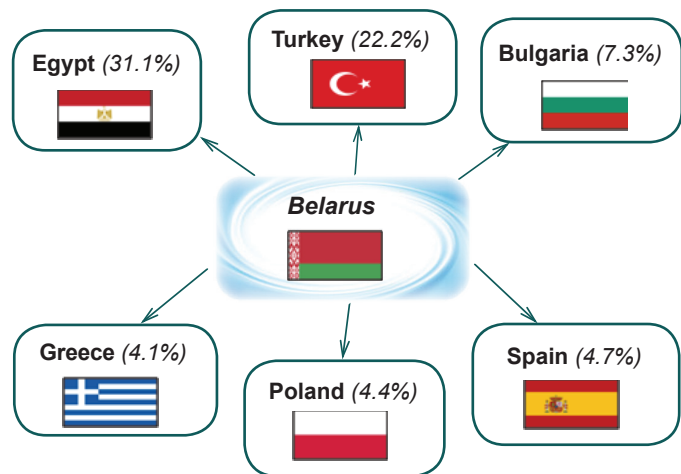
Inbound visits to the Republic of Belarus

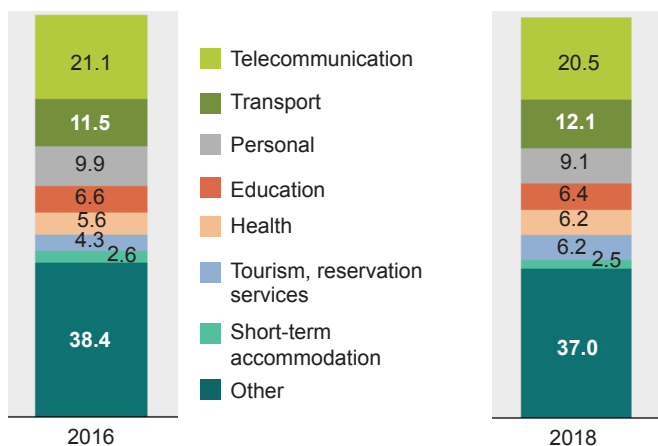

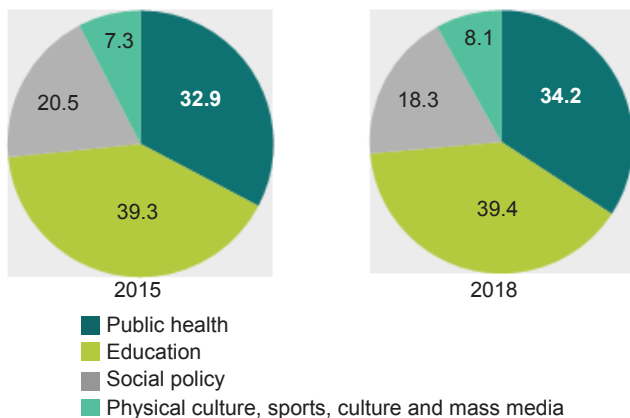

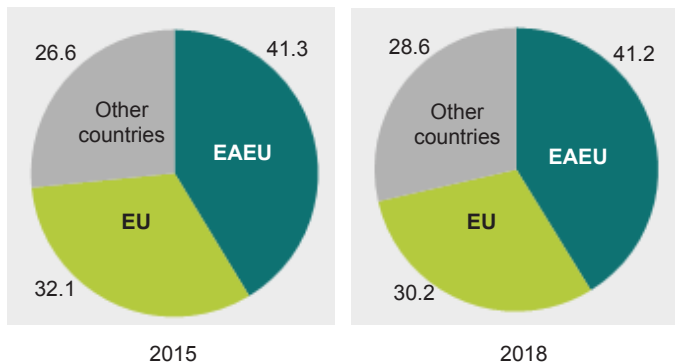

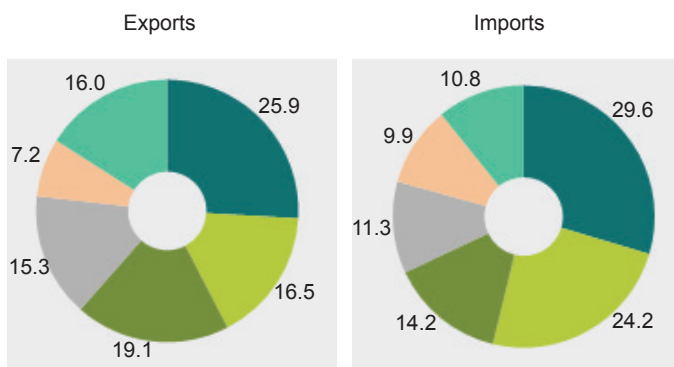
DISTRIBUTION OF EXPORTS OF GOODS BY COUNTRY GROUPINGS

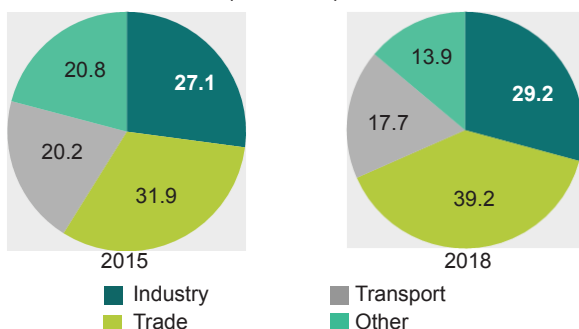

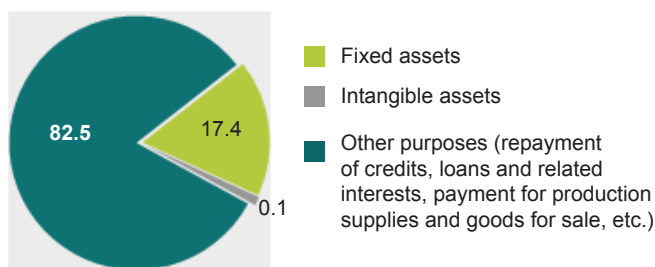

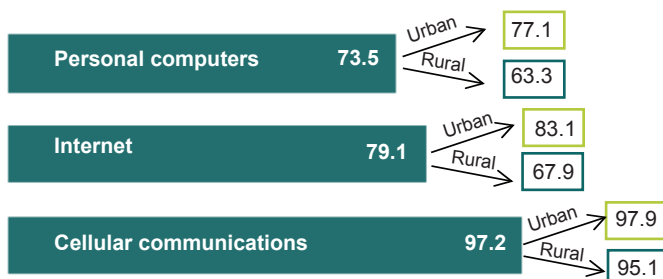
