



by place of residence














EMPLOYED PERSONS BY STATUS OF EMPLOYMENT ICSE-18

WHO IS WHO?

IICSE-18 – International Classification of Status in Employment

ICSE-18-A

Type of authority – describes the degree of control a worker has over the organization he/she works for, over his/her business and whether he/she can organise his/her work independently

organisation owned by a relative.

ICSE-18-R

Type of economic risk – defined according to the level of worker's exposure to loss of financial or other personal resources in carrying out his/her activities and the degree of risk of not receiving remuneration for the work done

Employers employ workers on a permanent basis.

Own-account workers do not employ any persons engage any employees.

 $\boldsymbol{Employees}$ work under an employment agreement (contract) regardless of its term.

Dependent contractors are self-employed persons who are not employees of the economic unit but have commercial contractual relations with it. They do not have a total control over the activities of the economic unit but depend on it as regards organisation and execution of the work, income, or access to the market.


