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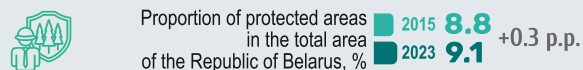

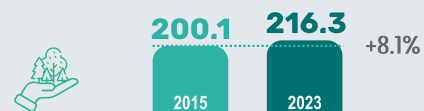

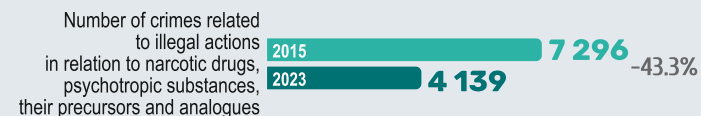

According to the results from the International Comparison Program 2021 cycle, for GDP based on PPP, Belarus ranked 62nd among 173 countries

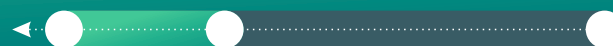

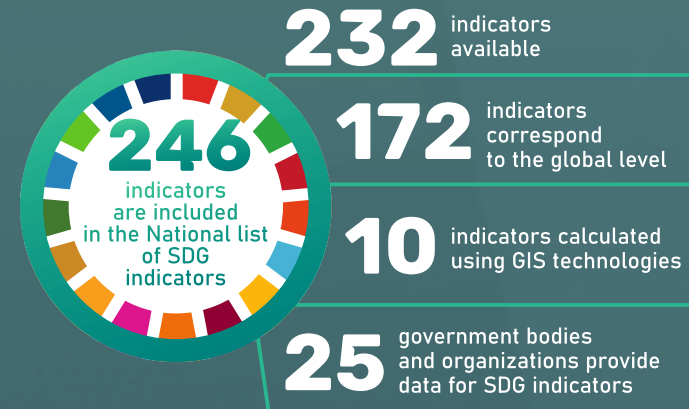
RANKING OF COUNTRIES IN TERMS OF PERFORMANCE TOWARDS THE SDGs, 2024

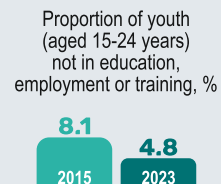
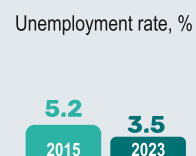
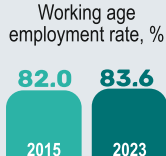
