MAIN CHARACTERISTICS OF THE REPUBLIC OF BELARUS

STATE STRUCTURE

The Republic of Belarus is a unitary democratic social state governed by the rule of law.

The state power in the Republic of Belarus is exercised on the principle of division of powers between legislative, executive and judiciary.

The President of the Republic of Belarus is the Head of State, the guarantor of the Constitution of the Republic of Belarus, of the rights and liberties of man and a citizen.

The All-Belarusian People's Assembly is the highest representative body of the people's power of the Republic of Belarus, which determines the strategic directions of the development of society and the state, ensures the inviolability of the constitutional system, the continuity of generations and civil accord.

The Parliament – the National Assembly of the Republic of Belarus is a representative and legislative body of the Republic of Belarus, consists of two Chambers: the House of Representatives and the Council of the Republic.

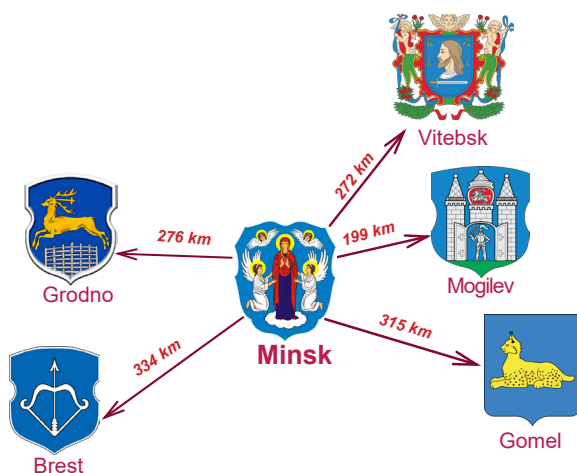
Executive power in the Republic of Belarus is exercised by the Government – the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Belarus, which is the central body of state administration.

The judicial power in the Republic of Belarus is exercised by courts.

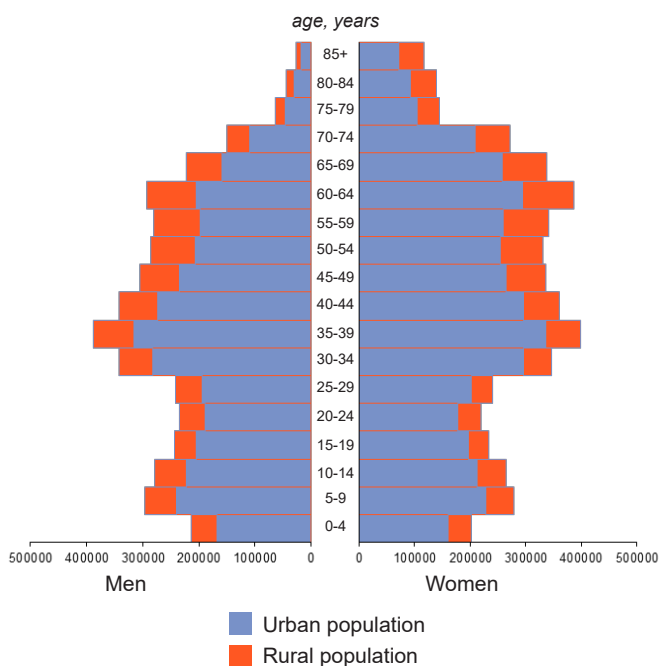

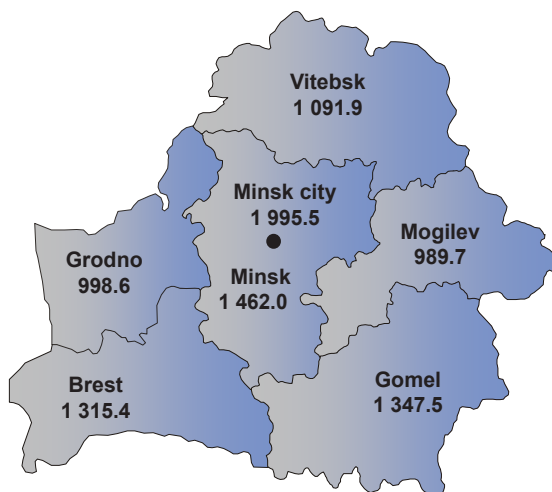
AGE-SEX POPULATION PYRAMID (as of January 1, 2023; persons)

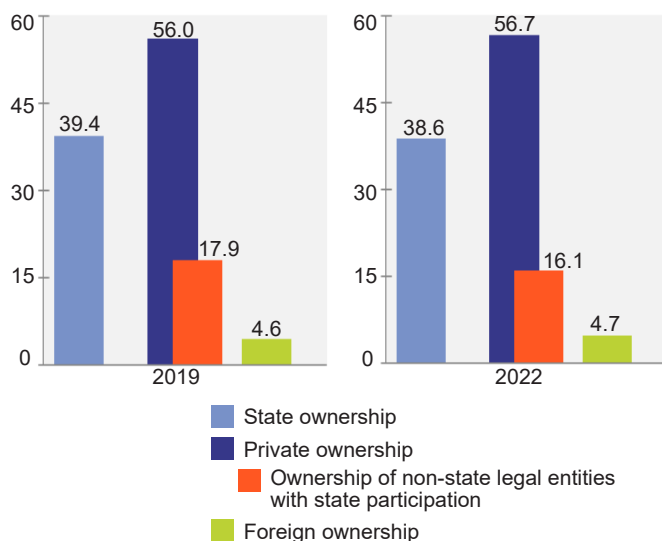

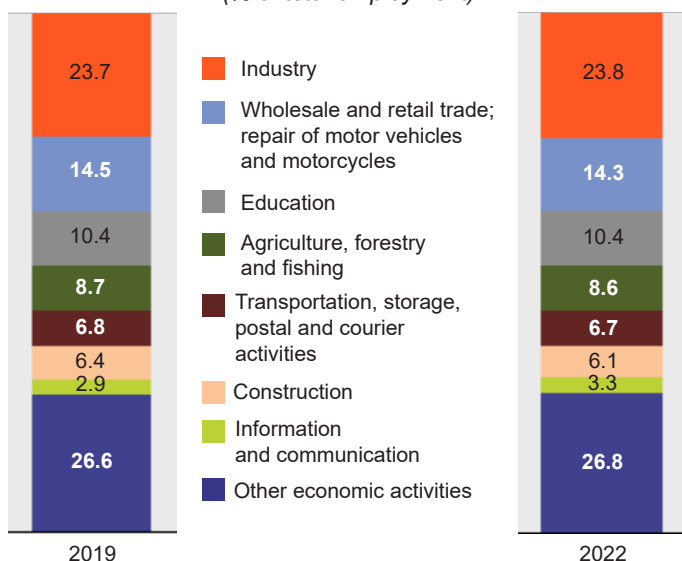

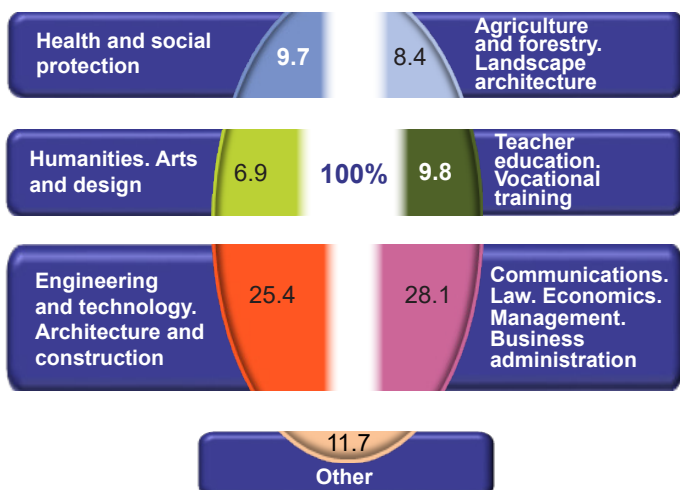

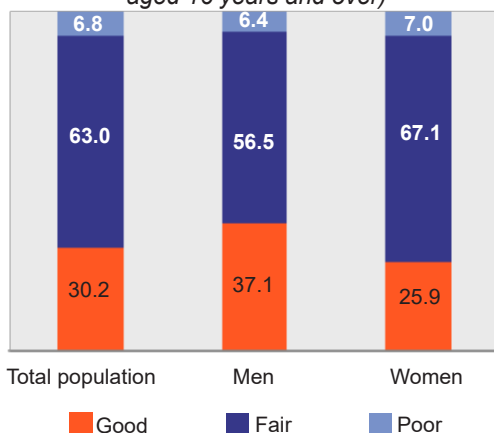

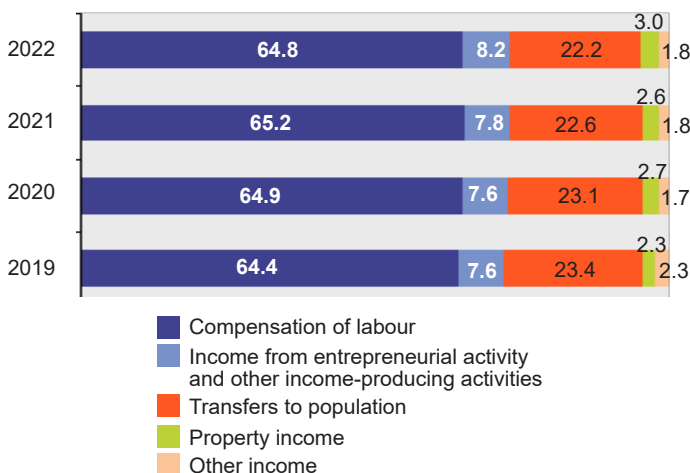

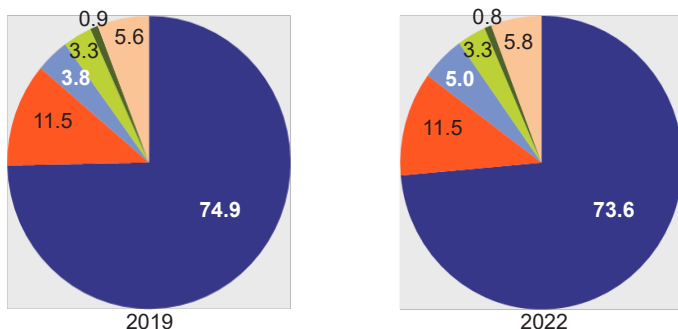

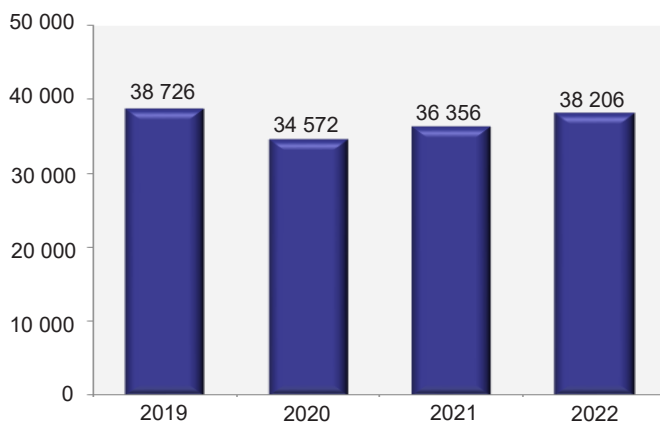

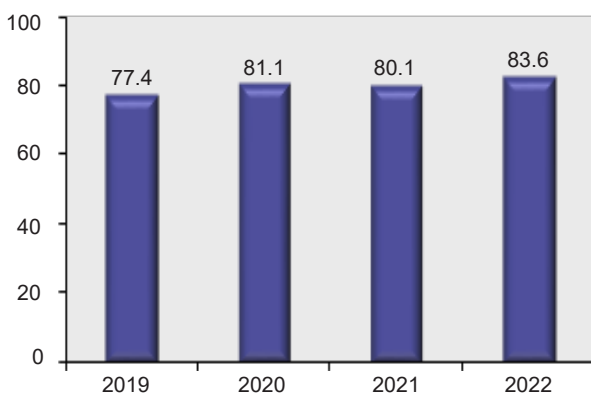

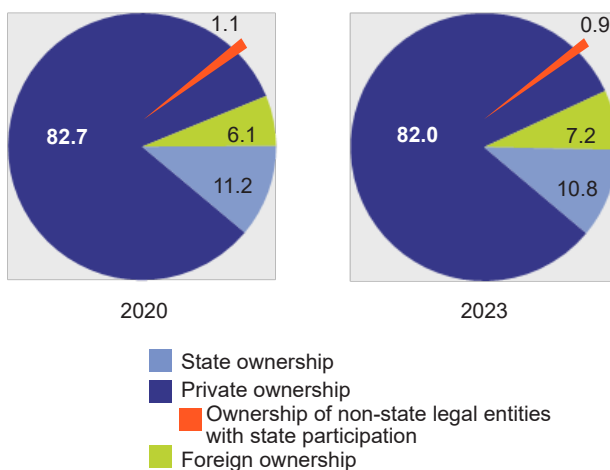

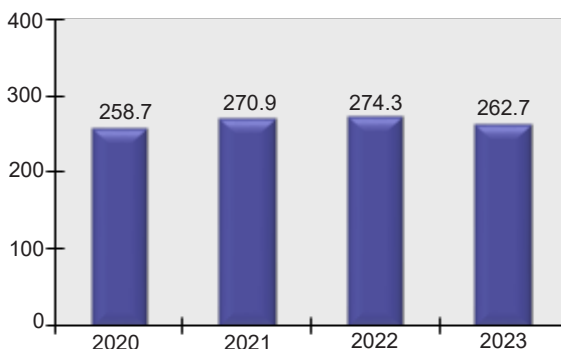

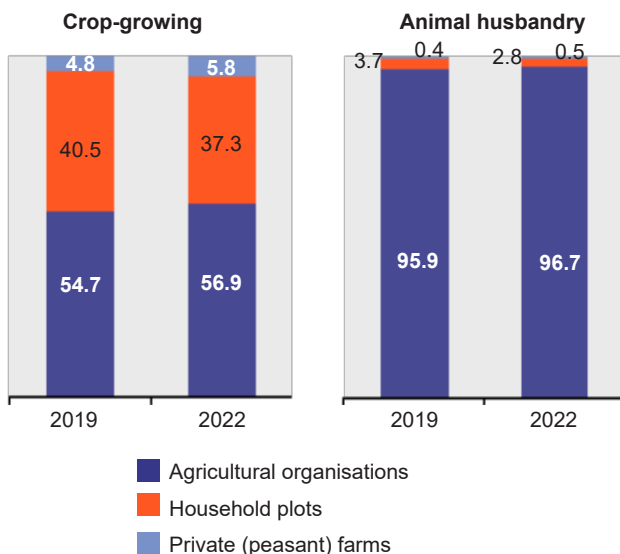

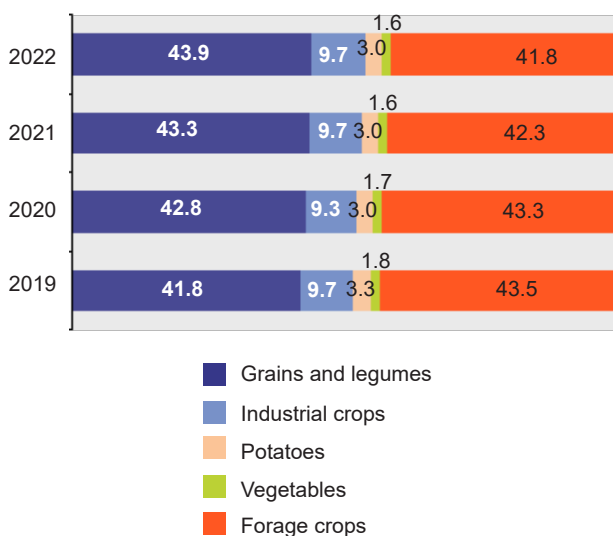
STRUCTURE OF CROP-GROWING AND ANIMAL HUSBANDRY PRODUCTION BY TYPE OF FARM

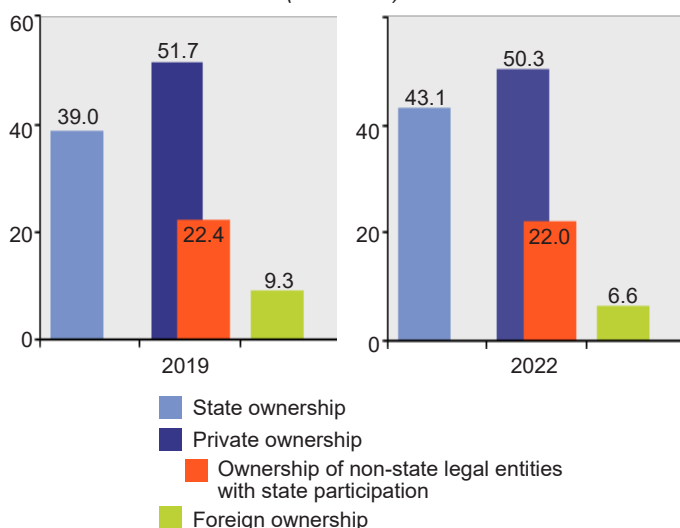

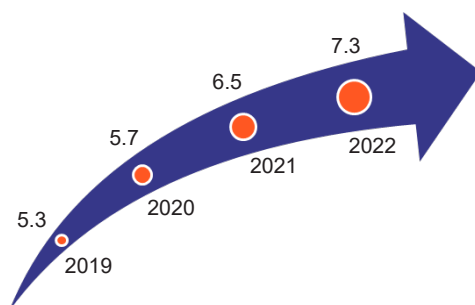

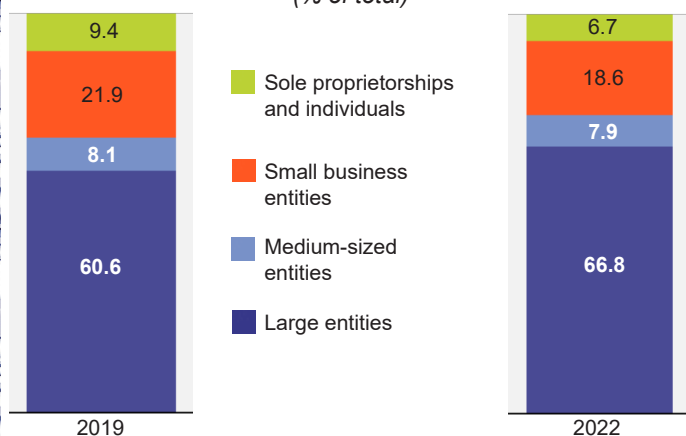
RETAIL TURNOVER PER CAPITA (BYN thousand; at current prices)

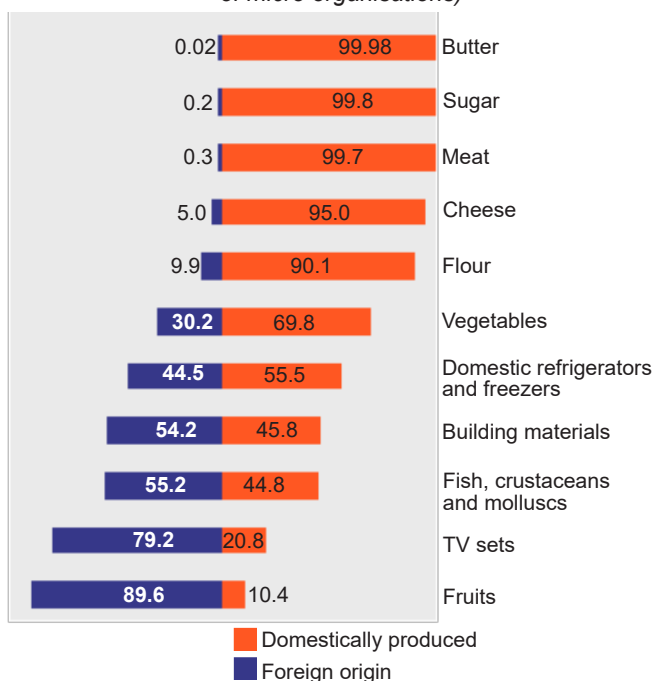
STRUCTURE OF RETAIL TURNOVER BY ECONOMIC ENTITIES

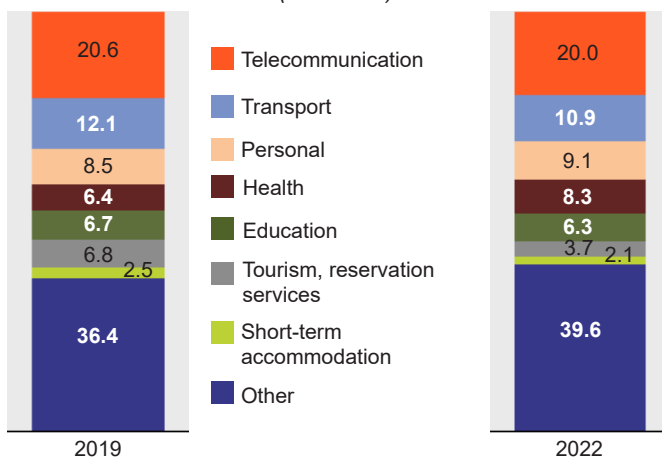

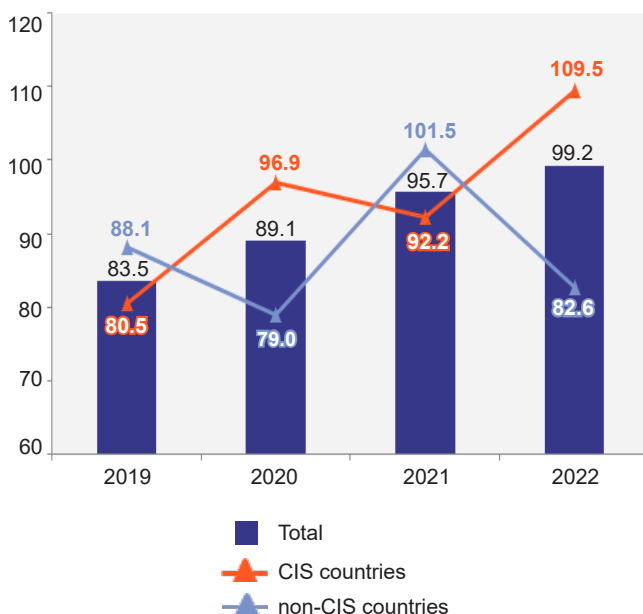

EXPORT-IMPORT COVERAGE RATIO

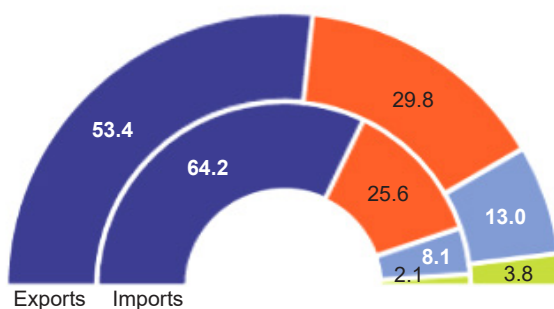

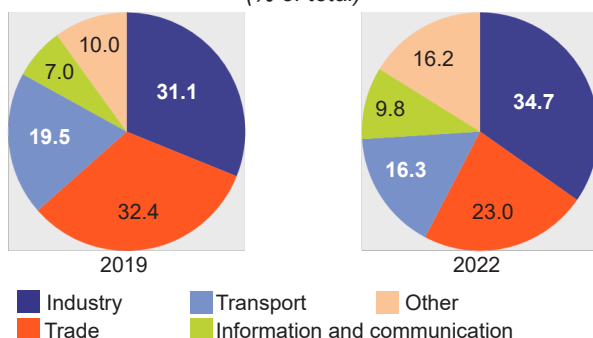
